- The original castle dates back to the 11th century, after the Norman invasion of England by William the Conqueror.
- Windsor Castle is the favourite weekend home of our current Queen, Elizabeth II.
- The royal family secretly lived at Windsor Castle during the Second World War, hiding from the bombs that were destroying parts of London.
- Several monarchs have added to and changed Windsor Castle's architecture over the years, so it is now a great mix of Georgian, Gothic, Tudor and Victorian design.
- Windsor Castle became a regular venue for royal parties and gatherings during Queen Victoria's reign.
